

JOINING INFORMATION

The weekend is centred around Wolvercote Primary School, First Turn, Wolvercote, Oxford, OX2 8AQ. St Peter's Church, for the concert, is directly over the road from the school, and The Plough is about a quarter of a mile away on the same road.



Parking

Parking is available for the weekend on the school playground and in front of the school buildings. This is limited, and we hope that there will be sufficient parking but we ask for considerate use of the available space (please avoid the soft playground covering) and wherever possible the use of car sharing, hotel parking and the local public transport would be appreciated. There is limited on street parking, and please check the restrictions if doing so. Unfortunately, motor homes and camper vans cannot park in the school car park. There is a height restriction on the park & ride carpark. As an overflow, we have agreed to be able to use the car park at the Leonardo Royal Hotel, only 5 minutes' walk away – there is a daily charge of around £6 to use this facility.
